### Grants, grants and more grants

It has been a busy time on the grant funding front. In our last newsletter we talked about submitting our proposal to the Energy Catalyst for a deep dive into the opportunity for our technology in Uganda. That application is still in the assessment phase, but in the mean-time we have been successful with two further applications: 'SEIIP' is a Scottish Government funded programme supporting socially-conscious innovators with international ambitions, and 'Fast Start' is an Innovate UK competition for innovations in Net Zero and Healthcare. More information on what we will be doing with these funds below.

## Social Enterprise Internationalisation Infrastructure Programme - SEIIP

They might not win any competitions for catchy programme titles, but the Scottish Government are putting their money where their mouth is with this funding that allows socially conscious enterprises like our own to explore how they can make a positive and sustainable difference. We are using these funds to contract The Challenges Group to conduct a Market Assessment in sub-Saharan Africa, with a particular focus on Uganda. Denis and Barbra from their Kampala office are leading this work, drawing on the fantastic knowledge and connections that they already have within Ugandan energy and green industries.

### **Fast Start**

This grant will fund a 6-month project to investigate new market opportunities for our river turbine technology in sub-Saharan Africa, focusing on those sectors where fossil fuel generators are widely used today. This will unlock new revenue streams for our business, save money for our customers, and reduce pollution and carbon emissions by displacing fossil-fuel generation. Again, we will be working with Challenges who will be evaluating the market opportunities, whilst the Kinetic Hydro team will be developing the product range to suit those needs.

# **MSIP Accelerator**

Kinetic Hydro were selected in a competitive process to join 11 other small enterprises in the 3<sup>rd</sup> cohort of the MSIP accelerator. This programme which will be delivered between September and Christmas is focused on putting hard evidence behind our business proposition and ensuring that companies are 'investor ready'.

We will be going out for equity fundraising in the new year, and this is ideal preparation to help put all of the parts of the jigsaw together in advance of that raise.
